- Proficiency in Microsoft Office, with a high proficiency in Excel. Knowledge of other data analysis software such as R, SAS, SPSS, is an asset
- Knowledge of data visualization software and strong technical ability to produce charts, graphs, etc.
- Exceptionally detail-oriented, organized, and collaborative
- Flexible team player
- Bilingual in French is an asset

### Duties and Responsibilities:

- Create, maintain, and implement data collection tools and instruments
- Oversee the maintenance of both short-term and long-term datasets

- Organize and manage large datasets (i.e., pivot tables, etc.)
- Create statistical charts and graphs (e.g., creative data visualization)
- Work with partner organizations and stakeholders to develop deliverables
- Develop research outputs (briefs, reports) that highlight key findings for a range of audiences
- Collaborate with the PFE team on a communications and social media strategy
- Be a key player in mobilizing knowledge to a wide range of public audiences
- Support PFE in conference participation: strategic planning, proposal writing, presentation, networking, and knowledge generation/dissemination
- Contribute to the PFE strategic planning cycle
