- Procure and assess key information about emerging public policies impacting education
- Create, maintain, and implement data collection tools and instruments

- Oversee the maintenance of both short- and long-term datasets
- Manage multiple research projects, schedule deliverables, and coordinate with stakeholders/partner organizations
- Conduct literature reviews and environmental scans
- Perform policy analysis and write research outputs (summaries, briefs, reports) that highlight key findings for a range of audiences
- Complete thorough media scans of current events and news related to education policy with the objective of information dissemination and sharing to the PFE team and partners
- Collaborate with the PFE team on a communications and social media strategy
- Be a key player in mobilizing knowledge to a wide range of public audiences
- Support PFE in conference participation: strategic planning, proposal writing, presentation, networking, and knowledge generation/dissemination.
- Contribute to the PFE strategic planning cycle.
